1. Old Minutes approved
2. Updates: West wall bid came in lower than expected. We will have a new compressor. Perhaps the old one could be up for sale. There are no drawings/ plans for the South side. We will be getting a new zamboni which means that there will be space for ads on the zamboni. Mt View currently has the space- the quandary about space and hospitals begins. BTW, the old zamboni is not for sale.
3. Wal Mart/IFYHA joint service project- painting went well- we earned \$5000.00. Do we want to do this next year?
4. Voting on secretary, Kristina Batalden nominated: outcome: Kristina will be secretary.
5. Director nominations: Brian L. was nominated for Midget division. Justin Dobson was nominated for Bantam division. Squirts and Mites need nominations. Girls director: Kathy Vernon would like to continue (nominated), Stacy Dogal was nominated by Joee Boyd for Pee Wee division director.
