Meeting Minutes from August: Approved- All in favor.

Business:

1. Ad in Parks and Rec booklet. We have two banners to hang for advertisements; we need places to hang them.
2. Petition for upcoming squirt girl to move directly to girls division was addressed. Committee, led by S. Lehto, recommended that the board does not approve this petition. Reasons: USA hockey regs state squirts aren't a checking league, therefore the girl has a place to play; the general feeling that it isn't wise to place a squirt aged player with 19 yr. old veteran players. L.Scott motions to follow recommendation and not approve. Brian seconded. All in favor.
3. Chamber of Commerce 'fee'. IFYHA didn't pay the fee because there is no benefit for our non-profit and it is difficult to make a chamber meeting.
4. IFYHA also changed HUB insurance and saved \$100.00
5. Ribbon cutting is Nov. 1 at 3:30. The large donors will receive a special tour of the facility because they gave so much.
6. Disciplinary rules addition. The board took a second look at the addition and decided to have Brian and Bill re-do the addition for a vote at the next meeting.
7. Rex Anderson provided the procedures for travel accounts and registration reimbursements. All travel teams will have a separate checking account with two signatures. Reimbursements will only be made because of injuries or illness and will be pro-rated. The changes and procedures were motioned and seconded and approved.
8. The fee for Robby Glantz was lowered but will be at \$90.00 per player this year. We will make adjustments for possible fifth group of players to participate based on the numbers.
9. USA Hockey challenge is to get two more new players than last year and keep two more players than last year.
10. Bev spent time shopping for trophy cases, TVs, dry erase boards, plaques and such to outfit our new rink. She is shopping for the lowest price on TVs, but was able to receive everything else.
11. Idaho tournaments are posted on the IAHA website.
12. AHA meeting is Sept. 18th in CDA.
13. Girls U-19 and U-14 travel declared Tier II. This will enable them to attend a premiere tournament in SLC.
14. Players can play on two travel teams if he or she is a member of the house team that corresponds with that travel team. However, a tier II player cannot play on the Midget HS teams because of 'possible' state rules that deny tier II players on a HS team. These rules will be discussed at the AHA meeting.
