Youth Coach Training Outline

This training outline is to be used by authorized representatives of the Idaho Falls Youth Hockey Association for the purposes of conducting the required training of youth student coaches. Additionally, re-certification of youth coaches will be accomplished annually.

1. Preparation

- a. *Student coaches less than 14 years of age must be accompanied by a parent during the training session*
- b. *Have student complete application and provide a copy to the Division Director*
- c. *Make sure that student's contact info is a home line or parent's cell number. Explain how information will be displayed on the website which is Name / Contact Number / Division Student Is Player In*

2. USA Hockey Requirements

- a. *The student must attend a training session conducted by the local association.*
- b. *While on the ice the student coach must wear a helmet with full face shield, gloves and skates. While on the bench they must wear helmet with full face shield.*
- c. *May not act as Assistant or Head Coach while on the ice.*
- d. *May only work with players at least one full playing age level down*
- e. *May only help during practices, tryouts or clinics. (May not play during scrimmages or games).*
- f. *Must always be under the supervision of a carded, screened adult coach during all practices, clinics, tryouts and in the locker room.*
- g. *The attached form must be filled out. At age 18 they must comply with USA Hockey coaching certification and screening requirements.*

3. I.F.Y.H.A. Requirements

- a. *Youth Coaches must be invited to participate in the practice by the Head Coach*
- b. *Youth Coaches must conduct themselves in a safe and mature manner. The student will be asked to leave the practice if any of the following behaviors are witnessed;*
 - i. *Any behavior that could jeopardize the safety of players, coaches or bystanders. Provide Examples:*
 - ii. *Any behavior that interferes with the flow of drills due to inattention or being in the way. Provide Examples:*
 - iii. *Any behavior that causes interruptions or excess noise during team discussions. Provide Examples:*
 - iv. *Any use of profanity*
 - v. *Any attempts to bully, intimidate, or demean players*
- c. *A maximum of two youth coaches per team will be allowed on the ice at a time.*

4. Roles and Responsibilities As A Youth Coach (as directed by the Head Coach)

- a. *Practice preparation / On-ice / Practice Wrap-up*
 - i. *Get water bottles*
 - ii. *Preposition equipment such as cones, coaches board, net blocker*
 - iii. *Assist players on / off the ice / Assist goalies with equipment*
 - iv. *Demonstrate drills*
 - v. *Drill prep / equipment set-up*
 - vi. *Gather and stow equipment*
 - vii. *Assist with nets during ice re-surfacing*
