Eagles take second in Jackson

The Idaho Falls Midget AA Golden Eagles returned home from Jackson, Wyo., on Feb. 11 with a firm grasp on the runner-up trophy after three days of hockey at the Grand Teton Invitational.

The action included a sudden-death overtime championship game, which went down to the final minute of play.

Other teams that participat-

ed included Helena, Mont.; Missoula, Mont.; Sun Valley; and the home team from Jackson, which was coming into the tournament with more than 20 wins this season and no losses.

Bonneville senior Ben Bowden led the Eagles with four goals for the tournament, and Skyline seniors Derek Heer and Taylor Braase each contributed four assists during the weekend.
