Idaho Falls tops Boise in boys hockey

At Boise, Logan Winterholler scored the game-winning goal late in the third period to lift the Idaho Falls Eagles to a 3-2, come-from-behind win over Boise on Saturday at the state midget tournament.

Boise led 2-0 after two periods before Idaho Falls rallied.

Jared Hergesheimer got things started, knocking home a seeing-eye shot from the point to make it 2-1.

Several minutes later, Ben Claver sent a diving pass to Hergesheimer, who skated in and scored his second goal of the game.

Winterholler, celebrating his 18th birthday, got the winner with 1:23 left when he took a pass from Devin Crighton and slapped a shot into the back of the net.

Austin Mooso kept the Eagles in the game while they were searching for offense. He finished with 34 saves.

Despite the victory, Idaho Falls lost on tiebreakers and was eliminated from the tournament.
